## Eastwood & Kimberley Advertiser 12<sup>th</sup> May 1916 WAINGROVES SOLDIER KILLED IN DUBLIN

Son of Mr Joseph Wyld, of Church street, Waingroves, was called to help quell the recent disturbance in Dublin.

The sad news was received on Monday that he was killed in action about April 27<sup>th</sup>. The brave youth, who is only 20 years of age, had only been in training since January last, being one of the first attested single men to be called up. He was drafted from Watford where he was in training, to Ireland.
